

# Logical Diagrams

Shown below are four basic forms of logic. The diagram first is comparison/contrast. The difference between 1) and 2) is that 1 is contrastive logic while 2 is comparison logic. The second diagram is a narrative organization or a process analysis. The third diagram is analysis logic in context, the standard form for academic essays. The final diagram is argument logic, which combines three issues and their supporting details into a position with evidence.
